Benno's Dream, a 14.2H imported chestnut German Riding Pony stallion, has a commanding presence, charm, charisma and magnetism rarely seen in a pony or horse. He has proven himself many times over as a champion and prepotent sire. From generations and decades of careful breeding, **Benno's Dream** produces elastic movement, jumping talent, impeccable disposition, and breeds true to pony size. His pedigree includes a warmblood, four generations back, the world class sire Grannus who is reliably reflected in each subsequent generation. Grannus was "the pony maker", number one sire of jumpers, producer of seven Olympic horses, 60+ approved stallion sons and several million Euro in winnings. **Benno's Dream's** damsire competed in combined driving paired with another Welsh stallion to amass over 60 wins against horses in Germany. His motherline is one of "stallion makers". Both sire and dam lines contribute dressage and jumping talent, intelligence and work ethic. In Germany, **Benno's Dream** won his 30 day stallion test (first of 32) with the unprecedented score of 8.95, including a "10" on rideability. He was the Landchampion of Weser-Ems. By the age of six, he had sired six colts that qualified for the Elite Foal Championship; he sired a stallion korung winner and another of his sons was also licensed at that korung. Since import, **Benno's Dream** has become a pony standing above horses. At his first USDF show, the 2003 Heidelberg Cup, he had high score of show, an "8" on gaits and comments appreciative of his "uphill carriage and suppleness". He took three of three blue ribbons at the Greater Atlanta Dressage Southern and two blues at the Raleigh Capital Dressage Classic. **Benno's Dream** received high score at AWR, ASPR and ISR inspections, including "9's" on jumping. Comments included: "Elegant ... lovely suspension and extension, floating trot with ground covering rolling canter." He is a First Premium Premiere sire for ASPR and AWR, receiving the highest score given to mature horses and ponies in North America in 2003. He has the highest index score (237.5 points) of all stallions (horse and sport pony) inspected by ISR/OldNA in 2003 and 2004. With effortless and impeccable jumping style and natural talent for piaffe, passage and extended gaits, strong work ethic and kind disposition, he is an ideal sire for all sport disciplines for children, amateurs and professionals.
